

Reading Eggspress Spelling Year 3 Answer Book

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In this book

The **Reading Eggspress Spelling** program provides instruction on spelling rules, strategies and generalisations. Each lesson focuses on a core set of 20 words, plus 10 challenge words to extend students. Answers are included.

The crafted word lists are based on the sound, structure and meaning of words, and were created to align with the following components of the Australian Curriculum:

Australian Curriculum content codes and descriptions

ACELA1480 – Know that word contractions are a feature of informal language and that apostrophes of contraction are used to signal missing letters

ACELA1485 – Understand how to use letter-sound relationships and less common letter patterns to spell words

ACELA1486 – Recognise and know how to write most high frequency words including some homophones

ACELA1826 – Understand how to apply knowledge of letter-sound relationships, syllables, and blending and segmenting to fluently read and write multisyllabic words with more complex letter patterns

ACELA1827 – Know how to use common prefixes and suffixes, and generalisations for adding a suffix to a base word
