## Reading Eggspress Spelling Grade 2 Student Book

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The Reading Eggspress Spelling program provides instruction on spelling rules, strategies, and generalizations. Each lesson focuses on a core set of 20 words, plus 10 challenge words to extend students. The crafted word lists are based on the sound, structure, and meaning of words. They support teaching of the following elements of the State Standards:
