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# In this book

The **Reading Eggspress Spelling** program provides instruction on spelling rules, strategies, and generalizations. Each lesson focuses on a core set of 20 words, plus 10 challenge words to extend students. The crafted word lists are based on the sound, structure, and meaning of words. 


