Reading eggs

Reading Eggs is designed to support early reading skills in a fun and motivating way. The programme features hundreds of reading lessons and interactive activities to teach young children phonics, letter recognition and sight words.



Reading EGGSpress

Reading Eggspress is designed to teach children in Years 2 to 6 essential reading, comprehension, spelling and grammar skills. The programme includes 220 comprehension lessons, 216 spelling lessons and over 2500 e-books in the online library.



Reading eggs Junior

Reading Eggs Junior builds essential language and pre-reading skills in toddlers. It's the perfect way to introduce young children to learning to read, and features interactive activities, fun nursery rhymes, entertaining videos and read-aloud books. The programme promotes learning, curiosity and play.



Mathseeds

Mathseeds makes learning maths easy and fun for children aged 3 to 9. The programme teaches essential early maths skills and concepts up to a Year 3 level, with 200 highly engaging lessons and tons of motivating rewards.



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Using your family dashboard

Your family dashboard is where you can track your child's progress, adjust their level, reset the placement test and access supplementary material.

Logging in

Taking the Placement Test

The first time your child logs into Reading Eggs they are asked to do a Placement Test.

The Placement Test will place your child on the appropriate reading lesson.

They will need sound enabled to complete the test.

Navigating the programme

The navigation screen shows the various places your child can visit. Reading Eggs keeps children motivated by rewarding them along their journey. Your child can see which lesson they are up to and check how many golden eggs they have earned.



My Lessons

The 120 reading lessons are the core of the programme.



Storylands

These 20 lessons contain 140 activities that cover emergent and early reading levels 1–10 and build reading, vocabulary and comprehension skills in the land of Clinker Castle. Storylands is available after lesson 60.



Spelling

This section focuses on building essential spelling skills. To access this area, your child must have completed reading lesson 40. You can always see your child's progress in the parent dashboard.



Driving Tests (Assessment)

This section consists of tests covering sight words, phonic skills and content-area vocabulary. When your child successfully completes a test, they are rewarded with a racing car game. Driving Tests can be accessed after lesson 40 is completed.



Story Factory

This section opens up a world of story writing with a weekly story writing competition. Your child can access the Story Factory after they complete lesson 10.



House

Each child can visit their house and find all their belongings, including any critters collected and Story Factory stories they have submitted. This is available after lesson 10.



Awards

This is where your child's awards are shown on their trophy shelf.



Games

Your child can earn golden eggs for completing reading activities. These can be used to play games and purchase shop items. Games are available after lesson 5.



Shop

Here's where children can change the look of their avatar and house by purchasing accessories with their golden eggs. The shop is available after lesson 6 is completed.



Puzzles

Your child can complete word puzzles and practise sight word recognition whilst being rewarded with golden eggs! Puzzles are available after lesson 40 is completed.



Critters

After each lesson, children are rewarded with a great new critter to add to their collection.



Play

This room consists of seven sections with over 120 fun and exciting activities.



Songs

Children can access all of the fantastic songs from within the ABC Reading Eggs lessons, all in one fun spot.

The My Programme feature provides more than 350 fiction and nonfiction books that match your child's reading level.







Over 2500 e-books to explore!



The **Reading Eggspress Library** has more than 2500 e-books on its shelves. It spans quality literature, poetry and drama texts, as well as a wide range of informational texts on historically significant and topical world issues.

What does the Reading Eggspress Library offer your child?

- Books for all ages and reading abilities, from years K–6, levels 0–34 and Lexiles BR–1680L.
- Books that meet year-specific text complexity requirements to help your child succeed in school.
- Engaging, levelled questions for each book to assess your child's reading comprehension.



Library book features

Children can 'fave' a book and bookmark where they are up to. They can also rate and review each book. When your child first chooses a book, they can read other children's reviews and see its rating.



All books can be accessed on iPads, tablets and all computers with internet access.

How to find the books you need

Use our extensive search functions in the library. You can search for books by **topic, series, author, reading age, Lexile or book title**. For example, to locate texts about machines for a Year 3/4 reading level:

1. Select Search, type in 'machines'



2. Drag the pointers to specify an age range or Lexile. The shelves display books for you to browse.



Navigating the programme

The Reading Eggs Junior navigation screen lets your child quickly visit the Books, Videos and Activities areas. Alternatively, they can select Explore the Lands to go to the sliding navigating screen.



Avatar
Your child can choose from a range of gorgeous avatars.

Books
Your child can discover over 250 beautifully illustrated fiction and nonfiction books, which feature read-to-me audio. These books are organised into sets based around fictional characters and high-interest areas. After each book, your child will earn a sticker.

Video of the day
The video of the day is displayed on the blimp flying across the top of screen. Selecting this will take your child directly to that video.

Activity area: Reggie and Friends
This area focuses on the everyday experiences of a child. Each egg opens an activity map which develops vocabulary, alphabet skills, fine motor skills, visual matching or letter formation.

Activity area: The Eggs
Your child can learn about sounds, music and following directions. The activity eggs focus on developing phonemic awareness, listening skills, memory and letter sounds.

Activity area: Animal Alphabet
This area focuses on animals, the alphabet and visual discrimination. The activity eggs build your child's sorting skills, letter recognition, phonemic awareness and alphabet knowledge.

Stickers
The sticker book displays every sticker your child has earned by completing activities, videos and books in the programme.

Book of the day
The book of the day is displayed on the boat at the bottom of the screen. Selecting this will take your child directly to that book.

Progress reports
As your child advances, you'll receive regular updates on their favourite books, videos and activities. View your child's progress in your parent dashboard to see their skills and interests develop as they play.

Videos
The video catalogue provides hundreds of animated and real-life videos. These videos focus on phonemic awareness, sequencing and alphabet skills. After watching a video, your child will earn a sticker!

Activity maps
Activity maps are opened by clicking on an egg in an activity area. There are three activity eggs in each area. These activities build memory, problem solving, listening, fine motor and higher order thinking skills. Each map contains multiple levels or parts, which unlock as your child advances. Levels gradually increase in difficulty and can be repeated as many times as your child wants. Your child will earn a sticker at the end of each activity and unlock a special video at the end of each map.

Logout
Click the Logout button to return to your parent dashboard. You will be prompted to enter a three-digit number before exiting the programme.
